The Topaz Ranch Estates General Improvement District (TREGID) will hold a special meeting on August 19, 2021, at 6:00 PM at the Topaz Ranch Estates Community Center. The purpose of the meeting will be to discuss applying for funds that might become available from the Infrastructure Bill that recently passed the United States Senate. It is expected that approximately 6 billion dollars will be awarded to the State of Nevada for infrastructure projects. TREGID could apply for funds to upgrade all or a portion of the roads in TRE, or funds to complete upgrading our water system. TREGID could also use grant funding for necessary drainage maintenance or constructing a Maintenance Building. da
