At some point TREGID received an invoice for the repairs that was never paid. Due to the lack of payment, the invoice was sent over to an attorney for collections.

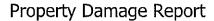

RE: SPB Utility Inc. Contract

Recommended Action:

Consider the contract presented by SPB Utility Services, Inc. and authorize the Chairman to sign contract on behalf of Topaz Ranch Estate General Improvement District.

Background Information

Due to the lack of a Certified Water Operator of the degree necessary to operate a water system of the size of Topaz Ranch Estates Water, it is necessary to contract with a third party to provide "oversight" and training to operate the District's water distribution system.

This contract exceeds the prior contract in the base amount by \$700 per month (or \$8,400 per year). While mileage remains the same \$0.90/mile, the travel time has increased from \$78/hour to \$90/hour. Additional operational support will cost \$90/hour based upon a fee schedule and added is a \$65/hour fee based on a schedule for compliance management.

Changes to the other items in the contract is a limit of a 2-hours to the monthly visit. Extra hours will cost extra. In addition to the compliance management support, (via phone or email) where prior there was no limit is now limited to 1 hour between the Chairman and/or Vice-Chairman. Extra hours will cost extra.

There is no official termination to this agreement, but either party can terminate the agreement in writing with a 30-day notice.

Financial Impact:

The entire base contract will cost \$20,400 plus approximately \$1,000 a year for mileage. Of course, extra trips to Wellington, extra training will all cost extra. Under the old contract I had budgeted for \$15,000 this contract. At the budget hearing we will have to increase this budgeted amount to at least \$25,000.
